Restore All Bilingual Staff in Southwest Detroit

Whereas: This is a *racist* attack against the rapidly growing Latina/o community in Southwest Detroit, especially those *undocumented students* & *their families* who don't know English. For these students & their families, the secretaries & other staff who are bilingual mean *everything*.

Whereas: These staff, going far & above the call of duty for ordinary secretaries, *serve as vital translators* on the phone, at the front desk, for councilors, teachers; *everything*. The Emergency Manager is well aware of this, and is trying to *push the undocumented youth to out of Detroit Public Schools* by denying them access to translators.

Whereas: Western is already <u>overcrowded & utterly fails</u> to meet the needs of its growing Spanish speaking population by not providing ELA, science, math and history taught in <u>Spanish</u>, which is what is <u>truly needed</u>. Therefore, bilingual secretaries and other staff are literally the <u>only pathway to learning</u> for Spanish-speaking students.

Whereas: Our futures, and the futures of our classmates, brothers, sisters, & the many thousands yet to arrive in Detroit, from Mexico or Central America, are *depending on us to act now*.

Whereas: This attack <u>would never even be attempted</u> if Southwest & the rest of Detroit had full democratic and political control of our city; even more so if voting were extended to those with & without papers- who live, work & attend school in Detroit- <u>people who should, in a just society, already</u> be considered citizens.

Therefore: We the undersigned demand:

- Re-hire all bilingual staff across Southwest Detroit
- All classes must be available in English AND Spanish
- Reduce class size at Western International High School to 25
- No retaliation against students or teachers who organize and/or take action to save their staff
- Restore the democratic rights to the people Southwest & the rest of Detroit.
- Extend the right to vote to include those with and without papers- anyone who lives, works, or goes to school here should be considered a Detroit citizen, and should be able to determine how their city is run.
